Provision

Literacy

- Withdrawn from French for Literacy lessons lowest attaining students in Year 7 **£13089**
- 1:1 Better reading /reading recovery 2 x 15 mins a week - delivered by TA 15 students working with a year 10 reading partner **£346**
- Lexia 2 x 30 mins a week supported by TA **£3549 (includes cost of Lexia)**

Impact after Autumn Term

Better Reading Partners

15 year 10 students were trained to support reading through the delivery of the better Reading Partners scheme. The year 10 student is given a year 7 student to work with twice a week during registration time. The students have built a strong rapport with their year 7 pupil and all students have improved their reading both in terms of accuracy and fluency. The scheme will continue to run this term to embed progress and develop reading comprehension.

Literacy withdrawal/Lexia

Students with low prior attainment at KS2 reading SATs were identified prior to transfer and withdrawn from French for additional literacy. The class is supported by a TA2 with a specialist teacher and HLTA for the non-specialist teacher group. Morecambe Bay Academy has purchased licenses for Lexia . Students now receive 2 x 30 mins Lexia with TA/HLTA a week and 2 x 30 mins literacy using a phonic based multi-sensory program with a teacher.

Intervention for Numeracy

Students with low prior attainment at KS2 maths SATs were identified prior to transfer and placed in a smaller settled class in both halves of the year. Both classes are supported by a specialist numeracy TA3.

In addition students receive an additional 1 hour a week for 10 weeks 1:5 for numeracy intervention. The weakest students also complete the Power of 2 program daily (5-10 mins) with a TA each morning before school.

Numeracy

- TA support in maths lessons for the lowest set in each half of the year **£4520**
- 1 hr a week for 10 weeks working on basic numeracy skills with TA3 **£446**
- Power of 2
