Charles' Law

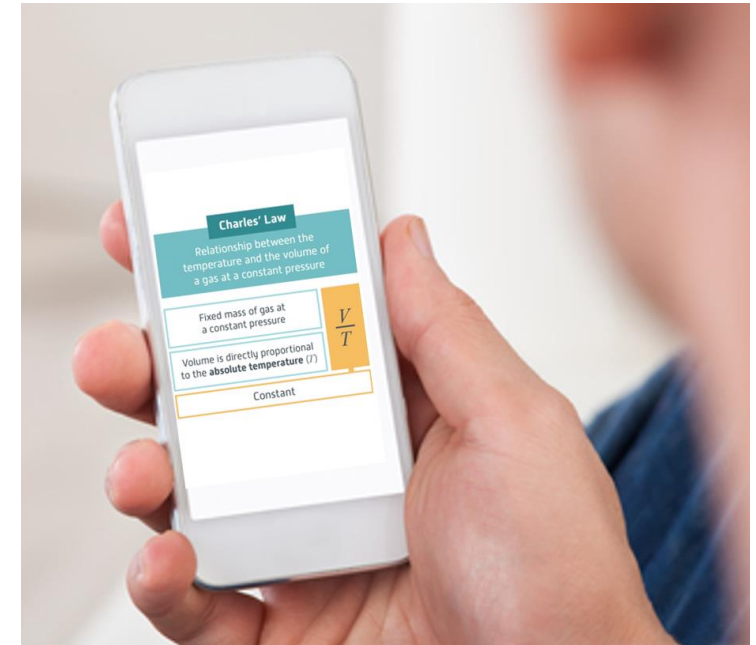
Relationship between the temperature and the volume of a gas at a constant pressure

Fixed mass of gas at a constant pressure

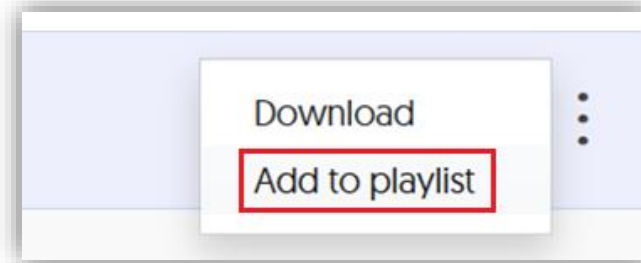
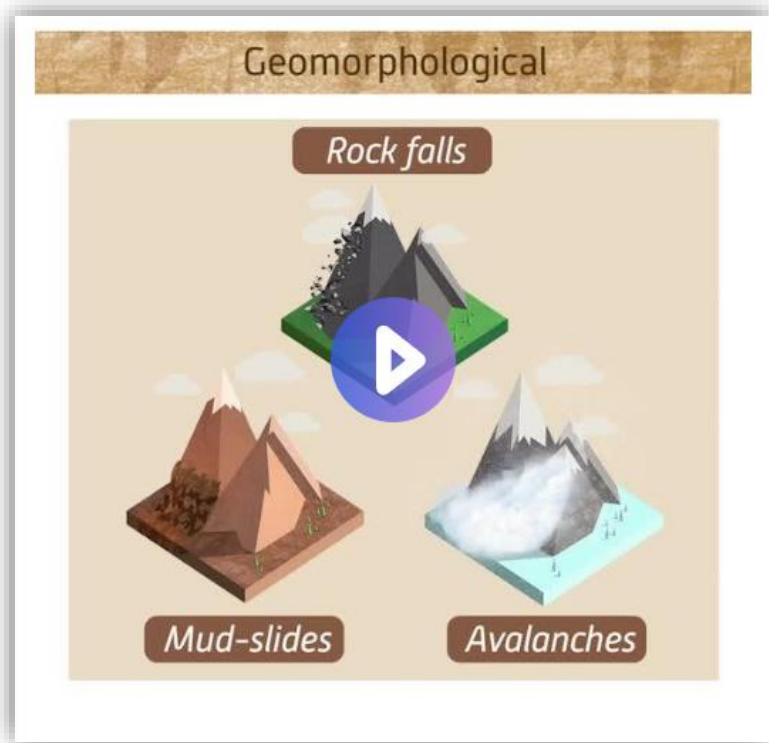
Volume is directly proportional to the **absolute temperature** (T)

Constant

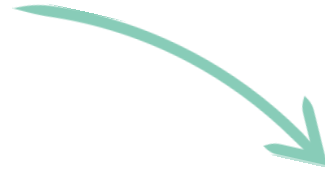

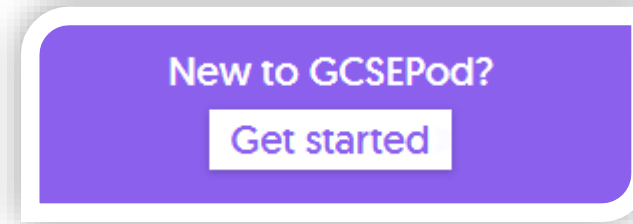



Signing into your GCSEPod account for the first time


1. Go to: <https://members.gcsepod.com/login>
2. Click 'New to GCSEPod? Get Started'
3. Select 'Student'
4. Enter your **first name, last name, date of birth** and the name of your school.
5. A blue button will appear below, click this to set up your GCSEPod username and password to log in.
