The Pastoral Team will not know about the content of any conversations unless there are safeguarding concerns.

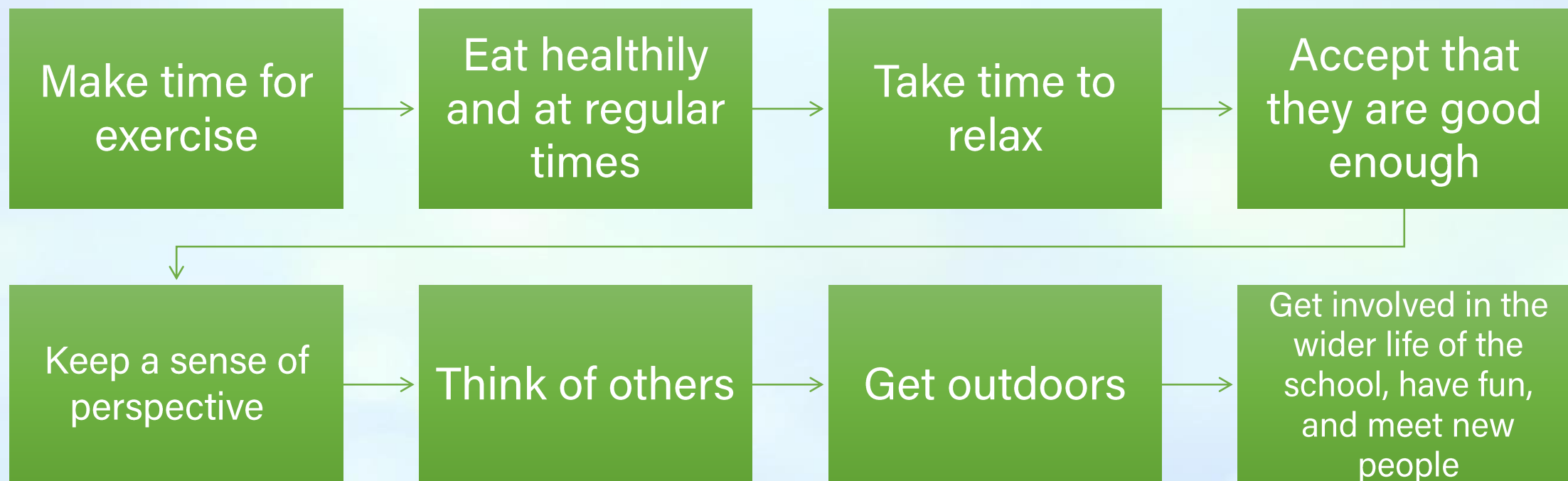
Students may access these services without your knowledge.
