Job Purpose:

To Support the PE department fulfilling a range of practical, technical and administrative duties.

Supporting teachers and pupils to access practical learning activities is an essential part of the role.

- Prepare a wide range of equipment/tools for use by teachers and students in the Gymnasium/Training Hall and on relevant sports pitches
- Clean and undertake basic maintenance routines on equipment and tools used in all sports areas
- Set out and clear away equipment required by school teaching staff and assist in the production of resource materials and teaching aids such as worksheets, plans and coursework

- Provide support to students and teachers during lessons in the use of all PE resources
- Undertake replenishment ordering and storage of equipment, under the direction of teachers
- Organise detailed fixture lists for a variety of sports by liaising with staff within the department and from other schools
- Co-ordinate and arrange transport to external fixtures
- Keep records in accordance with the school's record retention schedule and data protection law, ensuring information security and confidentiality at all times.
- Actively safeguard and promote the welfare of children at all times
- Ensuring First Aid boxes are replenished
- Top be a key first aider with in the department (Training provided)
- Ensuring school-owned PE kit (rugby / football / athletics) is washed as necessary
- Managing lost property, within the department
- Contributing towards the department and school's co-curricular activities.
